There will be a special called Business Meeting today following the morning worship service. Below is the recommendation from the Building & Grounds Committee and the Finance Committee. This will be voted on today.

Recommendation: The ice machine in the Fellowship Hall is out of order. The compressor is out and will cost \$1,072.68 to repair. The price of a new ice machine will be \$2,153.08 plus tax. Our machine was purchased in 2004 and has required several service calls in the past few years. Since the repair is almost half the cost of a new one, and because of the age of our old machine, the committees recommend that we replace the ice machine instead of repairing it.



To The Congregation of Churchland Baptist Church;

I would like to personally thank each of you for your generous monthly contributions and food, your prayers and the volunteering time that you have given serving our community. In 2018 we were able to serve 2,239 households, reaching 7,471 people in those homes. We were also able to add 208 new families.

In our weekend feeding program, we were able to send home approximately 151 student food bags each Friday to our 3 elementary schools for the 2017-2018 school year. That is over 6,040 bags of food. During June, July and August to continue our weekly ministry, we sent special Summer Food Bags home with any clients having children in their households.

We were also able to send out 202 Christmas meals to needy local families, and to help organize and supply 141 children at all 5 of our schools with Angel Tree Christmas gifts.

Through our Clothing and Homegoods Ministry, we distributed over 12,000 pounds of clothing, shoes, toys and housewares to our clients.

None of this would have been possible without your continued support and generosity. I wish each of you many thanks!
