

Through the last several years we have focused more on our local foster care community. We have a great working relationship with our Davidson County DSS and other private agencies that work in foster care in our area.

Our community of supporters has been more than generous. We now provide each child who enters foster care with a \$100.00 Gift card, a clothing bag with three new outfits, socks, underwear, blanket, Bible and also a comfort bag that has the necessary hygiene items.
