Deacon Ordination Service - 2026

For

Jody Lomax and Andrea Strauss

“Heed the Call”

Text: Acts 20:28-31

THEME

The deacon’s ministry call is to be taken seriously and with great care.

I. TAKE HEED TO THE CALL OF INTEGRITY (VERSE 28)

A. Examine Your Self (verse 28a)

“...take heed to yourselves...”

B. Examine Your Families (verse 28b)

“...take heed to...all the flock...”

II. TAKE HEED TO THE CALL OF UNITY (VERSE 29)

“...after my departure savage wolves will come in among you, not sparing the flock.”

III. TAKE HEED TO THE CALL OF PURITY (VERSE 30)

“Also from among yourselves men will rise up, speaking perverse things, to draw away the disciples after themselves.

IV. TAKE HEED TO THE CALL OF LONGEVITY (VERSE 31)

“Therefore watch, and remember that for three years I did not cease to warn everyone night and day with tears”.
